Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2016-17 educational progress for the West Bloomfield School District. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The district report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2016-17 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

State law requires we also report additional information.

1. All students at the transition center reside in the West Bloomfield School district or have enrolled in the district under cooperative agreements.
2. The West Bloomfield Transition Center provides school-based and community-based instruction that helps students ages 18-26, whom have received a Certificate of Completion from his/ her high school, transition to leading independent, productive adult lives. Students must have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) written each year, in which the IEP team recommends the post-secondary program is needed.
3. To access information regarding the curriculum taught in any elementary school, middle school or the high school in the district, contact the main office at any school or the office of Teaching and Learning
