## How does this affect class size?

- 700-780 students per cohort (The building is designed for 2000.)
- Approximately 18 students per classroom



## Cleaning Procedures

- Hand Sanitizer stations in every classroom
- High touch surfaces between cohorts
- Rooms and bathrooms with increased frequency and between cohorts
- Facilities management are doing dry runs to time out the sanitization process and ensure we can safely prepare school for each cohort.
- Minimize non-students in building, guests require
 to complete health questionnaire to enter


## Arrival and Dismissal

- Entrances and hallways monitored by staff and marked for social distancing
- Doors will open 20 minutes before the start of cohort
- Students MUST be off campus within 20 minutes at the end of their assigned cohort. (due to cleaning and to ensure health and safety) 10:37 AM Cohort and 2:40 PM Cohort


## Transportation

- Opt in bussing ONLY
- Fewer students per bus, mask wearing required
- Consistent bus seats for contact tracing
- Busses will be disinfected after each route
- Parking passes
- All 16 year olds and older
- Reduced rate for early purchase - Email coming soon
- Drop off and Pick up
- Front north loop


## Food Services

- All students have access to free breakfast and lunch through June 30 regardless of income
- Food provided twice a week, a week's worth of food
- Grab and Go format, following the MS model
- No food may be consumed on campus

- Orientation to the building
- 9th Grade - Monday and Tuesday, January 25-26
- New Students - Wednesday, January 27
- Acclimating to a new environment
- Access help and support when you need it
- Routines, procedures, and building norms


## Health and Wellness

- This will be an adjustment for everyone and may be accompanied by mixed emotions - and that's okay!
- What you might expect to experience
- How to connect to extra supports
- Your counselors are here for you
- When in doubt, reach out!
- Allowing yourself time to transition

## Cohorting

- The primary goal in cohorting students is to ensure students can be safely distanced in the classrooms.
- Aligning with the Middle School model we will try to keep students in the same cohort as younger siblings.
- Specialty programming will be considered
- Cohort assignments will be based on managing class sizes throughout the day. (NOT tied to address or alpha)
