WHY TAKE A SUMMER COURSE?

- To get prerequisites out of the way
- To earn credit and create more space in next year's schedule, so you can take band, orchestra, choir, AP courses, or dual enroll
- All online summer courses must be pre-approved by your child's counselor before enrolling for classes

Online Summer Courses \$325 per course

Algebra 1A* and Algebra 1B*

In these two separate courses, students will learn about algebraic concepts such as integers, linear equations, inequalities, and factoring. As students work through each interactive lesson, they will have the opportunity to complete several self-check activities and journal entries.

Students enrolling in Algebra 1A and 1B MUST successfully complete Algebra 1A (at least 60%) before taking Algebra 1B.

Civics*

This one-semester course prepares students for informed and responsible participation as citizens in the American representative system. Students deepen their awareness of the values expressed in the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and other foundational documents of the United States. Students learn the purposes and structures of government within the American federal system.

Economics*

This course is designed to provide an overview of the ways that economics affects the lives of individuals and how individuals, through their economic choices, can shape their world. This one-semester course provides an overview of the basic principles of microeconomics and macroeconomics, including: a) economic theory; b) supply, demand and price; c) economic systems; d) business cycles; e) investments; f) the role of government, g) international trade; and h) consumer choices. Students will also apply the principles of this course to issues related to personal finance.
