If you or anyone you know has a child that will turn 5 on or before September 1, 2020, it is time to begin registration for Kindergarten. Or if you have a child that will be 5 on or before December 1, 2020, you are able to fill out a state waiver to attend kindergarten.

Gretchko is having a Kindergarten Showcase/Round Up on **Thursday, January 30** at 6:30 p.m. Please join us and bring your student. You will be able to meet other new students and their families, Mrs. Drummond will present information and answer questions about curriculum and the coming school year. However, if you wish to **have a sibling** of one of our current School of Choice students attend WB Schools, **you must apply for School of Choice for the sibling**.
