Summer Reading

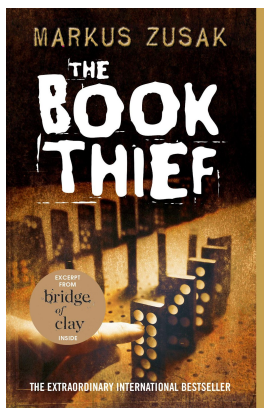
