THERE'S MORE TO READING TOGETHER THAN JUST SAYING THE WORDS

Try asking your student questions like these when you read together.

Talk about the book

Is this a real story or a made - up story? How can you tell?

What can you tell by looking at the cover of a book? Talk about the title, author, and pictures about the story.

Where is the top of the book? Where's the bottom? Point to each.

Talk about the words

Example: Valiant means brave. Can you tell who was valiant in the story? Can you think of people in other books where were valiant?

Example: How many words can you think of that sound the same as "doom" – room, broom, boom, etc. (pick a word that is familiar from the story).

Talk about the story

How are the characters feeling in this part of the story? Scared, nervous, brace, etc. Who do you think is in charge, How can you tell?

What do you think will happen next, etc.?

MORNING DROP OFF REMINDER

<u>Our car loop supervision stops at 9:12 a.m.</u> to allow our staff to be in position for school to start. <u>The SIDE ENTRANCE doors will be locked at 9:12 a.m.</u> and you will need to park your car and bring your student to the front office to check in.

Please remember, <u>school begins in the classroom at 9:15 a.m.</u> At that time students should be in the classroom with their coats off, lunches put away, and ready to learn.

CAPTURING KIDS' HEARTS PROGRAM AT GRETCHKO

Capturing Kids' Hearts is a positive reinforcement program that is used by West Bloomfield Schools to help create a culture that supports the success of our students. We would like to share expectations of Capturing Kids' Hearts with parents. The following initiatives are being followed through our daily routines at Gretchko.

- * Teachers greet students at the door as they enter the classroom each morning.
- * Classroom Social Contracts are used regularly.
- * Students reference the Social Contract to help create an environment that places ownership and responsibility on the students in the class.
- * Staff and students use the thumbs up to reinforce acceptable behaviors.
- * Thumb sideways is used to remind students to "check" their behavior to see if it is acceptable under the classroom Social Contract.

The following questions are asked if a student needs redirection from a negative behavior.

- 1. What are you doing?
- 2. What are supposed to be doing?
- 3. Are you doing it?
- 4. What are you going to do about it?

TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT UNVEILS BUS TRACKER APP

Durham Transportation is rolling out a new bus tracking app for West Bloomfield families. The Bus Tracker app is available for iOS, Android and web and allows families to track their student(s) bus along its route, to and from school. Families will need to have their student(s) ID numbers which are available in PowerSchool in order to log into the app and create an account.

SAFELINE PARENT REMINDER

Don't forgot to call the safeline at (248) 865-6572 if your child will be late or absent from school. Any unreported absence is considered an un-excused absence on your student's record.

PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING SCHOOL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The best opportunity for all students to learn is if all students are in attendance and the teacher has the least disruption as possible. **Late students** (interrupt lessons already being taught), **absent students** (miss lessons and take time to catch up), and **students leaving the classroom early** (create unnecessary interruption to all students and staff).

* Students that arrive late 1 hour or more to school will be marked absent for the morning.

- * Students that <u>leave school 1 hour or more before the end of the school day</u> will be marked absent for the afternoon.
- * Students absent for vacations will be marked unexcused.


