KIDS IN CHARGE COMES TO GRETCHKO FIRST AND SECOND GRADERS

West Bloomfield School District has always been a strong advocate for substance abuse and drug prevention education. For the past 29 years our district has provided a parent volunteer "Kids In Charge" prevention program. This year our district improved and revised the program so that our physical education teachers will include the program in the school classroom curriculum. Surveys show that students who have had Kids in Charge curriculum in elementary school, use substances at lower levels than other students in our county and the nation.

During this school year the first grade and second grade students will be introduced to the KIC program. You can expect follow up information to come home about the program the week before your student begins the program in their physical education class.

The Greater West Bloomfield Community Coalition, West Bloomfield Education Foundation and West Bloomfield Township partner together to fund the KIC program. The Greater West Bloomfield Coalition is reliant on sponsorships and funding from our community so that we may continue our prevention efforts. It is very expensive to run this program. Bus information is NOT available through the Gretchko office. If you would like to request a shuttle to Scotch, or an area unloading area, the shuttle requests are on the WB website. The shuttle busses are limited and are provided as a first come first served basis. If you are unable to locate the shuttle bus information, please contact the Transportation Department at 248-865-3680. Please be aware we anticipate busses will arrive home late at the start of school. You may be assured that your child's safety is of primary concern to all of us.

The information on this form must be <u>complete and legible</u>; otherwise the background check will not be processed.

The West Bioomfield School District reserves the right to approve or deny any volunteer or consultant service upon review of the background check returned. The determination will be based upon the individual's fitness to have responsibility for the safety and well being of children. Providing false information or information contradicting to the background check information is grounds for immediate volunteer denial.

As a volunteer or consultant, you must abide by all relevant Board of Education policies and administrative guidelines while volunteering for the District. Although volunteers are covered under the District's liability insurance policy, you are not covered by its health insurance policy nor are you eligible for workers' compensation. Should you become ill or suffer an accident while doing volunteer work for the District, you shall be responsible for any and all medical charges that may accounte. As a volunteer or consultant, you are not in any manner considered an employee of the District or entitled to any benefits provided to employees.

You must understand the procedures, polices and expectations that govern field trips for which you are volunteering to chaperone. The trip leader is responsible for the preparation and conduct of the trip and will provide chaperones with detailed information about the trip. Chaperones are required to model the behaviors expected of students at all times on the field trip. Inappropriate conduct on the part of a fellow chaperone or staff member must be reported to the trip leader as soon as possible.

By afficing your signature to this form, you acknowledge your statements to be true, understand the expectations for the West Bioenfield School District volunteers, release the Board of Education from any and all liability for damages, whatever their nature, which may result as a connegeunce of your volunteer service and give full consent to complete the requested background check. ICHAT background checks may be rerun at any time.
