Dear West Bloomfield Elementary Families:



# 2020-2021 ENROLLMENT DATE

Important things to know coming up:

- 2020-2021 Registration will begin on **Friday, May 22nd**.
- · Families may register online.
- Your account must be up to date with no outstanding balances.
  - If you register without paying your outstanding balance, then the registration fee will
    be applied towards your balance and your enrollment will be removed.
- If you do not pay the registration fee, the system will not enroll you.
- Once a school reaches capacity, enrollment for that school closes. You may put your child/children on a placement list.
- Enrollment closes August 14, 2020.

# **REFUNDS THIS SCHOOL YEAR**

All families' refunds have been processed. The refund covers the period of March 16th - April 30th, 2020. The refunds were allocated based on your child/children's schedules and based on how you paid your invoice. For example, people that paid with a credit card were refunded using their most recent credit card we had on file. Many families had to be reimbursed twice because their refund was larger than their last payment and the system will not allow us to refund over what was paid on the credit card. A few families were paid via check. Those who

are being reimbursed with a check, we ask you to please contact Collette if you do not get your refund by May 13.

We thank you for your patience as we processed these refunds.

## PLEASE NOTE:

Due to high enrollment numbers, enrollment will be capped for the 2020-2021 school year.

Once cap is reached, we will be unable to accept any more enrollments.

Do not wait to sign up. Kids Klub has limited spaces available!

## ALL Registration will close August 12, 2020!

- Kids Klub is an elementary school age childcare program available on school days from 6:45 a.m. until the start of school and then from dismissal of school until 6:30 p.m.

   Tween Time is our middle school program and is available on school days from dismissal of school until 6:30 p.m.

- Select your child's schedule:
   Register for the school your child attends.
  - Register for 5 days in a week, one day, two days, etc. (Kids Klub: a.m., p.m., or both) (Tween Time: p.m. only)

  - All children must be registered and committed to a consistent weekly schedule a month at a time.
     Schedules must be the same days each week. We are unable to change schedules weekly and we are unable to do an alternate week schedule.
  - Schedule changes need to be made by the 15th prior to the month.
- A \$10 schedule change fee will be applied for each schedule change.

- Invoices are <u>billed monthly</u> and always <u>billed a month in advance</u>.
- No credits can be given once the month begin
- Invoices will be emailed at the beginning of each month and payments are due on the 15th of the month.

- . Mail or pay in person by Cash or Check
- Pay online by clicking the "Pay Bill Online" link on your invoice transaction fee will be applied
- Set up your account for Auto Pay which will automatically charge your credit card on the 15th of the month. Transaction fee will be applied

# ADVANCED OR ACCELERATED MATH UPDATE

The West Bloomfield School District will be moving forward with the placement process for Elementary Advanced or Accelerated Math for the 2020 - 2021 school year. We would like to thank you for your patience and support during these unprecedented times. We have determined that entrance criteria will now consist of existing NWEA Math scores from Winter 2020, Fall 2019 and Spring 2019, Spring 2019 M-Step scores, Bridges Unit assessment scores and teacher recommendation. We will be using the next few weeks to look at this data to make our decision. As a result of the extended school closure, the Comprehensive Growth math placement test will not be used. **An email will be sent on May 15th with placement status results.** Please kindly contact your building principal or the district Advanced Math testing coordinator, Amy Quinn <a href="may.quinn@wbsd.org">amy.quinn@wbsd.org</a>, with any questions. # **MAGNET PLACEMENT FOR 2021**

Magnet

The West Bloomfield School District will be moving forward with the placement process for Magnet for the 2020 - 2021 school year. We would like to thank you for your patience and support during these unprecedented times. We have determined that entrance criteria will now consist of existing NWEA Math and Reading scores from Winter 2020, Fall 2019 and Spring 2019, Bridges Unit assessment scores and teacher recommendation. We will be using the next few weeks to look at this data to make our decision. As a result of the extended school closure, the CogAT test will not be a factor in the acceptance of the Magnet program. An email will be sent on May 15th with placement status results. A parent meeting via Zoom will be held on May 22nd at 6:00 pm for students who qualify for the Magnet program.
