We have been very busy this school year in the art room. several of our projects are on the walls throughout Gretchko. You may have seen some of the following while visiting Gretchko.


Kindergarten Plus- Pigs, polar bears, construction trucks and pigeons.


Open to all K-12 WBSD students (students do not need to attend showcase to submit entry)
