Please use the drop- off and-pick up pattern pictured below. The subdivision gate will no longer be available for cars to exit through. Please remember **our car loop supervision stops at 9:12 a.m.** to allow our staff to be in position for school to start. Please do not release children from cars without an adult to


accompany them. <u>The ENTRANCE doors will be locked at 9:12 a.m.</u> and you will need to park your car and bring your student to the front office to check in.

Please follow designated red arrows for Kindergarten, First and Second Grade car drop off and pick up.

PRESCHOOL — Preschool parents will be using the front (bus) loop to drop off and pick up their students. (see the star on map).

> IMPORTANT—To avoid a "waiting to turn left" line-up along Greer road—pass the school on Greer, turn left in the subdivision just past the school and return to the school for a right hand turn.

Parents, please drop off students between 8:55 a.m. and 9:12 a.m. so they may arrive in class on time. Elementary students begin their day in the classroom promptly at 9:15 a.m. ready to start their instructional day, Late arrivals interrupt our classroom instruction.

KINDERGARTEN SHOWCASE-ROUND UP - THURSDAY, JANUARY 30 6:30 P.M.


If you or anyone you know has a child that will turn 5 on or before September 1, 2020, it is time to begin registration for Kindergarten. Or if you have a child that will be 5 on or before December 1, 2020, you are able to fill out a state waiver to attend kindergarten. Gretchko is having a Kindergarten Showcase/Round Up on **Thursday, January 30** at 6:30 p.m. Please join us and bring your student. You will be able to meet other new students and their families, Mrs. Drummond will present information and answer questions about curriculum and the coming school year. We will have the students spend some time with Gretchko teachers, so parents are able to spend time learning about Gretchko's school year. We will also beginning the registration process for residents and present information about the School of Choice process.

If you have a student within Oakland County, do not live in West Bloomfield School District, and wish to attend Gretchko Elementary, you are able to enter West Bloomfield School District's School of Choice Lottery. The lottery is available online only, from **January 13th through February 11.** If you have a <u>School of Choice</u> student that already attends WB Schools, that student is expected to continue to attend WB Schools and you do not need to re-apply. However, if you wish to <u>have a sibling</u> of one of our current School of Choice students attend WB Schools, <u>you must apply for School of Choice for the sibling</u>.

PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING SCHOOL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The best opportunity for all students to learn is if all students are in attendance and the teacher has the least disruption as possible. **Late students** (interrupt lessons already being taught), **absent students** (miss lessons and take time to catch up), and **students leaving the classroom early** (create unnecessary interruption to all students and staff).

* Students that arrive late 1 hour or more to school will be marked absent for the morning.

* Students that leave school 1 hour or more before the end of the school day

will be marked absent for the afternoon.

* Students absent for vacations will be marked unexcused.
