

The goal of the Student Leadership class is to develop leadership skills and to provide students with opportunities that put these skills to use in order to positively impact our school and community. Students will learn to become an effective leader by developing skills in public speaking, problem solving, goal setting, record keeping, decision making, written communication, committee work, organization, time management, inter and intra-personal management and citizenship development.

THE CLASS
