If you are using an elementary shuttle location, please note we are now utilizing a sign system to assist with the dismissal of children in the afternoons. Each adult needs to be standing at the drop off area with a sign indicating the names of the children they are receiving. This can be a simple sheet of paper with the names printed legibly for our drivers to see. If you do not have a sign on any given day, your child will be the last to be delivered from the bus, allowing those with signage to receive their children first. We expect this process to create a safer environment for the children in the parking lot and an easier way to match up the students with their families.
