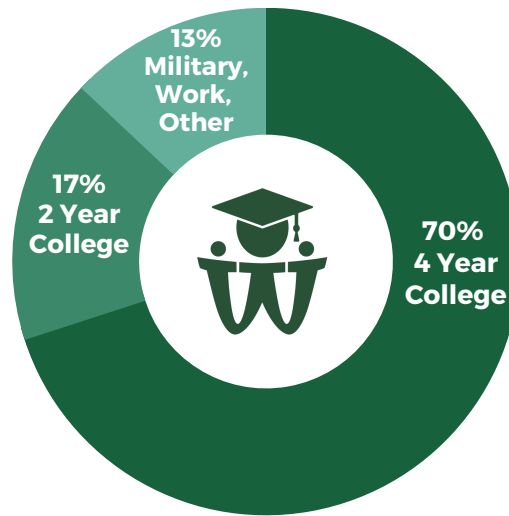

## COVID-19 IMPACT

COVID-19 grades have been calculated as follows:

- Students earning below 60% in a course automatically received a CC (COVID Credit) for S2 of the 19/20 school year only.
- Students earning above 60% could 1. Keep the letter grade OR 2. Change the grade to a G (credit only awarded, no impact on overall GPA) for S2 of 19/20 & 20/21 school years.
- Students had the option of attending Lakers Online, 100% virtual learning.
- WBSD has an agreement with Novi Virtual.

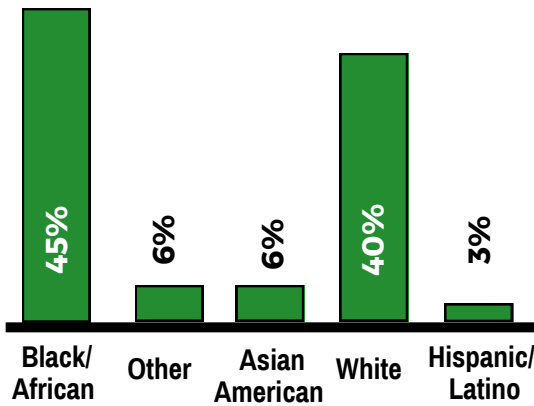
GPA calculations include all semester grades for both regular and weighted classes. West Bloomfield High School students are not ranked.

**DECA:** Five students earned the top 10 and 3 students earned the top 20 in the world. Earned Gold recertification for Laker Landing (School-Based Enterprise).

**Robotics Team:** 2019 & 2021 OCCRA County Champions out of 30 Michigan-based High Schools. Semi-finalists in the FIRST 2022 Season and acted as alliance leaders for FIRST Robotics at districts.

**Performing Arts:** Seven students performed in the MSVMA All-State Honors Jazz Choir in 2018, 2019, 2020, & 2022.

**Partnerships:** Henry Ford Hospital, Lawrence Technological University, local physicians, veterinarians, and businesses.

**The College and Career Center** provides opportunities for students to explore careers, attend college seminars, prepare for the college application process, and participate in an annual on-site admissions day. Students also learn about financial aid and scholarship assistance.
